Repeated Application for Confidential Designation Geysers Unit 19, Calistoga (81-AFC-1C)

Dear Chase Maxwell:

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received Geysers Power Company, LLC's (GPC or applicant) repeated application for confidential designation, filed April 20, 2022. The application covers the revised basis of design narrative submitted for the Unit 19, Calistoga facility.

The application states that the basis of design narrative was previously determined to be confidential for the life of the facility in a February 2, 2022 letter.

The repeated application notes that the revised basis of the design narrative for the Calistoga facility contains information substantially similar, and the facts and circumstances relevant to the confidentiality of the information remain unchanged.

California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4) states:

If an applicant is seeking a confidential designation for information that is substantially similar to information that was previously deemed confidential by the Commission pursuant to section 2508, or for which an application for confidential designation was granted by the executive director pursuant to subdivision (a)(3)(A) of this section, the new application need contain only a certification, executed under penalty of perjury, stating that the information submitted is substantially similar to the previously submitted information and that all the facts and

circumstances relevant to confidentiality remain unchanged. An application meeting these criteria will be approved.

The applicant has met the requirements of the repeated application.

Executive Director's Determination

For the reasons stated, the repeated application for confidential designation is approved and confidentiality is granted under the same terms as those in the February 2, 2022, executive director's letter. The revised basis of the design narrative will be maintained as confidential for the life of the facility.

Be advised that under the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2506, one may petition to inspect or copy records that the CEC has designated as confidential. A decision on a petition to inspect or copy confidential records is issued by the CEC's chief counsel. Under the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2507, the executive director may disclose records, or release records previously designated as confidential, in certain circumstances. The procedures for acting on a petition and criteria for disclosing or releasing records previously designated as confidential are set forth in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506-2508.

You may seek a confidential designation for information that is substantially similar to information for which an application for confidential designation was granted by the executive director by following the procedures in the California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4).
