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MOTION OF CALIFORNIA UNIONS FOR RELIABLE ENERGY FOR REMOVAL OF PARTY STATUS

Pursuant to section 1211.7 of Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations, California Unions for Reliable Energy ("CURE") files this Motion To Remove Party Status ("Motion") for the San Jose City Data Center, Docket No. 19-SPPE-04 ("Project").

On January 23, 2020 CURE timely filed a Petition to Intervene pursuant to Section 1211.7(a). Section 1211.7(a) grants "any person" the right to file a petition to intervene which sets forth "the grounds for the intervention, the position and interest of the petitioner in the proceeding, the extent to which the petitioner desires to participate in the proceedings, and the name, mailing address, e-mail address, and telephone number of the petitioner." Section 1211.7(c) provides that the "presiding member may grant intervention and may impose reasonable conditions on an intervenor's participation.... An intervenor is a party to a proceeding." CURE was granted intervenor status on February 14, 2020.

Section 1211.7(f) provides that "[a]ny petitioner may withdraw from any proceeding by filing notice to such effect." CURE now moves to withdraw as a party to the proceeding because it will no longer be an active participant. Therefore, CURE has good cause to submit this Motion to remove party status.

This Motion is timely. The Commission has issued a scheduling order with a deadline to file Prehearing Conference Statements by May 12, 2022 ahead of the

May 18, 2022 Prehearing Conference. CURE wishes to withdraw as a party prior to these deadlines.

For the reasons stated herein, CURE respectfully requests that the Commission grant its Motion to Remove Party Status in this proceeding and remove CURE as a party.
