Data Adequacy Supplement Introduction

This Data Adequacy Supplement #2 to the GEM A-CAES LLC (Gem) Application for Certification (AFC) for the Gem Energy Storage Facility (21-AFC-02), provides additional information in response to the California Energy Commission (CEC) Staff's data adequacy review of the AFC in the technical area of Cultural Resources corresponding to AFC Section 5.13. A Data Adequacy Supplement #1 addressing all other technical areas except Cultural Resources was filed on April 25, 2022. With the additional information contained in this supplement and the prior supplement, Staff should recommend that the AFC contains adequate data to begin a power plant site certification proceeding under Title 20, California Code of Regulations (CCR), and the Warren- Alquist Energy Resources Conservation and Development Act.

In order to facilitate review, Siting Regulation text citations and Information Requested by CEC Staff were taken verbatim from the CEC Staff's data adequacy recommendation and are placed with quotation marks ("") and indented in *italics formatted text*.

In order to help orient and facilitate the review of the supplemental Cultural Resources information, the following additional information is provided regarding the scope of work for the two cultural resources contractors who performed cultural resource and built environment studies for Gem:

- Cultural Studies for Project Site and Original Two Transmission Interconnection Routes Rincon Consultants, Inc. (Rincon)

5.3 Cultural Resources

1) Siting Regulation: Appendix B (g) (2) (B) – Technical Area: Cultural Resources

- "The results of a literature search to identify cultural resources within an area not less than a 1-mile radius around the project site and not less that than one-quarter (0.25) mile on each side of the linear facilities. Identify any cultural resources listed pursuant to ordinance by a city or county, or recognized by any local historical or archaeological society or museum."
- "Literature searches to identify the above cultural resources must be completed by, or under the direction of, individuals who meet the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Standards for the technical area addressed."
- "Copies of California Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) 523 forms (Title 14 CCR §4853) shall be provided for all cultural resources (ethnographic, architectural, historical, and archaeological) identified in the literature search as being 45 years or older or of exceptional importance as defined in the National Register Bulletin Guidelines, (36CFR60.4(g)). A copy of the USGS 7.5' quadrangle map of the literature search area delineating the areas of all past surveys and noting the California Historical Resources Information System (CHRIS) identifying number shall be provided. Copies also shall be provided of all technical reports whose survey coverage is wholly or partly within .25 mile of the area surveyed for the project under Section (g)(2)(C), or which report on any archaeological excavations or architectural surveys within the literature search area."

Information Requested by CEC Staff

- "Applicant's records search only covered 0.5 mile surrounding the project and no buffer at all directly east of the project site; please submit records search results extending to 1.0 mile for the area surrounding the project site. The project site is not identified on maps provided. Revise the maps to include the project site and the 1.0 mile buffer."
- "Please provide USGS 7.5' quadrangle map of the literature search area that includes the following reports currently missing from the literature search maps: KE-00355, KE-00519, KE-00634, KE-00802, KE-00803, KE-00869, KE- 01181, KE-01182, KE-01183, KE-01196, KE-01341, KE-01628, KE-01630, KE-01867, KE-01960, KE-02002, KE-02232, KE-02244, KE-02825, KE-02826, KE-02827, KE-02953, KE-02954, KE-03493, KE-03781, KE-03787, KE-03874, KE-03889, KE-04023, KE-04057, KE-04080, KE-04099, KE-04224, KE-04226, KE-04234, KE-04435, KE-04435A, KE-04749, KE-04833 KE-05013, KE-05043, KE-05163."
- "The confidential CR technical report states that 68 previous investigations have been conducted and documented within one-half-mile of the Project area since 1961 of which forty-seven of these studies encompass portions of the Project area. However, only copies of forty-five previous cultural studies were provided, of which two were not listed among the sixty-eight listed in the cultural resources technical report. Please provide copies of the remaining cultural studies within 0.25 mile of the area surveyed for the project."

2) Siting Regulation: Appendix B (g) (2) (C) – Technical Area: Cultural Resources

- "The results of new surveys or surveys less than 5 years old shall be provided if survey records of the area potentially affected by the project are more than five (5) years old. Surveys to identify new cultural resources must be completed by (or under the direction of) individuals who meet the Secretary of the Interior's Professional Standards for the technical area addressed."
- "New pedestrian archaeological surveys shall be conducted inclusive of the project site and project linear facility routes, extending to no less than 200' around the project site, substations and staging areas, and to no less than 50' to either side of the right-of-way of project linear facility routes. New historic architecture field surveys in rural areas shall be conducted inclusive of the project site and the project linear facility routes, extending no less than .5 mile out from the proposed plant site and from the routes of all above-ground linear facilities. New historic architecture field surveys in urban and

suburban areas shall be conducted inclusive of the project site, extending no less than one parcel's distance from all proposed plant site boundaries. New historic architecture field reconnaissance ("windshield survey") in urban and suburban areas shall be conducted along the routes of all linear facilities to identify, inventory, and characterize structures and districts that appear to be older than 45 years or that are exceptionally significant, whatever their age."

"A technical report of the results of the new surveys, conforming to the Archaeological Resource Management Report format (CA Office of Historic Preservation Feb 1990), which is incorporated by reference in its entirety, shall be separately provided and submitted (under confidential cover if archaeological site locations are included)."

Information Requested by CEC Staff

- "Confidential Appendix 5.3C does not show survey coverage for the project site; please provide scaled topographic quadrangle maps depicting the survey coverage, including buffer areas, for all project components surveyed. Compare to Confidential Appendix 5.3A, as additional resources might be in the survey area."
- "No new historic architecture field survey was provided. Provide a historic architecture field survey inclusive of the project site and the project linear facility routes, extending no less than 0.5 mile from the proposed plant site and from the routes of all above-ground linear facilities. The 0.5 mile buffer must extend from and include the linears' right of way."

"The AFC section does not discuss the resources identified by the survey, nor does it clearly route the reader to Appendix 5.3B for the discussion. No architectural field survey was performed. A built environment inventory was compiled, but there was no discussion of the methodology for creating this inventory in the survey methods section 6.1 of Appendix 5.3 B and no discussion of these resources was provided in the Architectural History Survey Results section of Appendix 5.3 B. Add a discussion of the background research methodology for compiling the Historic Built Environment Resources inventory in the study area to the Methods Section 6.1 in Appendix 5.3 B. Conduct and include results of an architectural field survey in Section 6.1 of Appendix 5.3B and summarize the methods and results in Section 5.3. Include a summary of the results of the archaeological survey in Section 5.3."

Refer to Attachment DA5.3-6 for historic architecture field survey that includes a 0.5 mil buffer of the project site. Methodology for creating environment inventory is discussed in Section 3 and historic architectural field survey results are summarized in Section 5 of Attachment DA5.3-6.
