California Energy Commission (CEC) staff is hosting a public workshop to discuss and solicit public comments on proposed modifications to the existing Energy Conservation Assistance Act (ECAA) program. ECAA is a low-interest loan program providing financing to cities, counties, schools, and other eligible public entities for energy-efficiency and clean energy generation projects. Assembly Bill (AB) 33 (Ting, 2021) provided for expansion of the ECAA program and staff are proposing adaptations to the program to incorporate the program expansion elements provided for in AB 33.

The workshop is being held in person and can also be attended remotely. The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the direction below. The CEC intends to begin the workshop promptly at 10:00 a.m., and the end time is an estimate.

During this workshop, CEC staff will present the proposed modifications to the ECAA program including applicant eligibility, project eligibility, and the way in which energy cost-savings are calculated for projects. A public comment period will also be included. Background

ECAA is a loan program that has been administered by the CEC since 1979. ECAA provides loans at a low or no interest rate cost to cities, counties, schools and other eligible public entities for energy-efficiency and clean energy generation projects. AB 33 expanded the type of measures eligible for loans under the program, provided additional flexibility in calculating energy cost savings, and expanded overall program eligibility.

Public Comment

Oral comments on the presentation materials will be accepted during the workshop. Comments may be limited to three minutes or less per speaker and one person per organization. Depending on the number of members of the public seeking to make a comment, the facilitator may adjust the total time allotted for public comment and the time allotted for each comment.

If participating via Zoom's online platform, use the "raise hand" feature to alert the administrator that you would like to make a comment after the lead commissioner opens the floor for public comment. If participating by telephone, press *9 to "raise your hand" and *6 to mute/unmute. A workshop administrator will call on you by the last three digits of your phone number.
