Public Comment

 Leslie Aguayo (Greenlining Institute): rebates in themselves can be inequitable; questions re: how AB 1550 definition of DAC vs. "underserved" (which is broader, could dilute funding to DACs)

DACAG Member Discussion:

- A lot of PUC programs focus on fleet charging. Lack of charging at ports/drayage sites. How to reconcile that with the TEF?
- One barrier = jurisdiction/geography re: which IOU serves ports/drayage sites?
- Spending to date: what is the timeframe to spend the remaining \$?
 - LD: most funding complete in 2024
 - MD/HD: perhaps funding complete in 2025 (will likely be a transition period for unspent \$; ensure that IOUs can wind programs down and serve all customers signed up to receive service)
- Reporting: emission reductions/charging stations etc. how to track outcomes/metrics?
 - Some deference to CARB, although CPUC has some data on usage and locations.
- DAC residents do not have access to single passenger EVs. Where is the room to address this issue in TEF? Question of access. Public transit options?
 - MD/HD will focus on public transit; IOUs work with transit agencies to electrify
 - TE advisory services: IOUs "handhold" for fleets
- ID the need for funds for community residents to participate; that has to be written into the program.
- Use of Funding: what guardrails are in place so that entities do not game the system? How do we ensure that the benefits of investments accrue to DAC residents?
 - CEC IEPR overlap; will address investments in DACs and hopefully determine guardrails.

• Need to address vehicle incentive programs and charging at the same time – avoid the chicken/egg problem, how do we ensure that the CPUC will align with CARB to move simultaneously and concentrate efforts?
