## No extension for Diablo Canyon Nuclear Facility

The operating license for Diablo Canyon nuclear power plant must not be renewed. The facility is old and unreliable. The risks are far too great and we are seeing examples around the world of just how great the risks of nuclear facilities are. The head of the IAEA has warned that the situation at the Zaporizhzhia Nuclear Power Station in Ukraine (the largest nuclear power plant in Europe), which has been seized by Russia, and which Russia is now shelling, is "out of control.― Additionally, Japan is planning to discharge very large quantities of treated water from the Advanced Liquid Processing System stored in tanks on the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant site into the Pacific Ocean for more than 30 years, starting in 2023. There is no safe way to dispose of nuclear waste. Do not renew the operating facility at Diablo Canyon. Renewable energy sources and reduction in the amount of energy we use must be the focus of our energy policy going forward.
