The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received CALCTP's (CALCTP or applicant) application for confidential designation, docketed June 27, 2022, covering:

The application requests confidentiality of these documents pursuant to California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4), stating that, on "November 13, 2013, the Executive Director of the California Energy Commission granted

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confidential status to the CALCTP ATTCP Curriculum materials, including online proprietary NRCA forms, and test bank questions."

On November 26, 2013, the executive director granted CALCTP's application for confidential designation of its "training modules addressing various technical areas an Acceptance Technician would need to demonstrate competence in before being certified." The basis of this approval was a determination that the application met the requirements for designating trade secret materials as confidential.

On April 18, 2016, the CEC approved an application for confidential designation of the following records:

- 1. CALCTP Acceptance Technician Curriculum
- 2. CALCTP Test Acceptance Technician Questions Bank
- 3. CALCTP Acceptance Technician/Employer Recertification Curriculum
- 4. CALCTP overview of changes to 2016 acceptance test forms
- 5. CALCTP Acceptance Test Employer Certification Curriculum
- 6. CALCTP Test Acceptance Employer Questions Bank

The basis of this designation was again that the materials were shown to meet the requirements of California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(3)(D) for trade secrets.

A review of the documents submitted with the pending application establishes that they are substantially similar to the documents previously submitted that were designated confidential. However, the regulation relied on for the current application, California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4), also requires that CALCTP assert the facts and circumstances relevant to the prior confidentiality determination remain unchanged. The application makes no reference to whether the circumstances remain the same as they were in either 2013 or 2016.

The applicant has not established that the documents qualify for confidential designation pursuant to California Code Regulations, title 20, section 2505(a)(4).

## **Executive Director's Determination**

For the reasons stated, the applicant's confidentiality application is denied.

The records submitted by CALCTP shall be deemed confidential for 14 days from the date of this letter, permitting the applicant to resubmit a request that satisfies all requirements. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 20, § 2505(3)(B).) If resubmitting, please provide

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the required information about whether the circumstances relevant to confidentiality presented in the earlier application remains unchanged.
