Dear Gov. Newsom and CEC,

I urge you to close the aging Diablo Canyon plant as promised.

To keep Diablo Canyon running, ratepayers from all of California's major utilities would pay a yearly bill estimated at \$460 million!! SDG&E customers could see a 3% increase to their electricity charges, according to some analysts.

In addition to cost, Gov. Newsom's proposed legislation raises other important questions. Years ago, the Legislature and stakeholders had agreed to close Diablo Canyon in 2025.
