While I would not be in favor of building additional nuclear power plants in California, I do support the continued operation of Diablo Canyon Units 1 and 2 for the foreseeable future. I had the pleasure of working at Diable Canyon iin the late '80s and was surprised by how professionally the plants were operated, especially compared with other nuclear power plants I had visited. The 2 GWe that Units 1 and 2 produce are not easily, nor quickly, replaced by renewables and it seems capricious to mothball a well functioning power plant, especially one with such a small carbon footprint.
