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NOTICE OF RECEIPT PETITION FOR POST CERTIFICATION CHANGE Alamitos Energy Center (13-AFC-01C)

On August 27, 2022, AES Alamitos Energy, LLC (AES) filed a petition for a postcertification change ($\frac{TN#245715}{}$) with the California Energy Commission (CEC) for the Alamitos Energy Center (AEC).

The AEC was certified by the CEC in April 2017 as a 1,040-megawatt (MW) power plant project, with a 640 MW combined-cycle, natural gas-fired power block, and two simple cycle gas-fired turbines that would produce 400 MW. To date, the simple cycle turbines have not been built. The 640 MW combined cycle portion of the project began operation in February 2020. The facility is located at 690 North Studebaker Road in the City of Long Beach, Los Angeles County.

SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGES

The project owner seeks approval to modify the AEC by installing two identical 1,112 brake horsepower emergency diesel-fired internal combustion engine (ICE) generators to provide emergency power supply to critical plant equipment in the combined cycle gas turbine power block during the gas turbine shutdown periods in the event of electrical emergency.

REVIEW PROCESS

This petition is reviewed pursuant to Title 20, California Code of Regulations, section 1769. The review process includes an evaluation of the effect the change could have on the environment; the project's compliance with applicable laws, ordinances, regulations, or standards; and whether a change to, or deletion of any condition of certification adopted by the CEC in the final decision or subsequent amendments is required.

After staff has completed its independent review and analysis of this petition, the assessment will be published for public review and comment. Included in the staff analysis, staff will provide written notice of its intent to either process the

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proposed changes as a staff-approved project change or schedule it for consideration by the CEC at a regularly scheduled business meeting.

PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

This notice of receipt is being mailed to the CEC's AEC mailing list of interested agencies, the public, and property owners that requested placement on the mailing list as well as to property owners within 1,000 feet of the facility site and 500 feet of the facility linear features (for example, pipeline). The notice is also being sent to the AEC list serve. The list serve is an automated CEC system by which information about this facility is emailed to parties who have subscribed.
