Opt-in Certification Overview

Solar photovoltaic power plant of at least 50 MW Terrestrial wind power plant of at least 50 MW

Energy storage system of at least 200 MWh



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Non-fossil-fueled thermal power plant of at least 50 MW (i.e., jurisdictional facility) Manufacturing/assembly facility for renewable energy/energy storage systems or components with at least \$250 million investment Transmission from an eligible power plant or energy storage system to the first point of interconnection

Statutory Framework

- 1. Pre-filing Meeting (Day -60)
- 2. Application submitted (Day -30); CEC requests additional information if necessary
- 3. Transmit application to responsible and trustee agencies and publish summary in newspaper
- 4. Application deemed complete (Day 0)
- 5. Notice of Preparation of **Draft EIR+** (Day 3)
- 6. Initiate tribal engagement (**Day 5 or earlier**)
- 7. Public EIR scoping meeting, informational meeting, workshop
- 8. Publish Notice of Availability and Draft EIR+ (Day 30-150)
- 9. Public comment period and public meeting on Draft EIR+ (60 days)
- 10. Final EIR+ (Day 240)
- 11. Business Meeting decision (Day 270)
- 12. Other agencies issue permits (if applicable) (Day 270-360)

2022 Emergency Rulemaking Process

- June 30: AB 205 signed into law
- July-Sept: Informal meetings with stakeholders
- Sept: Consultation with California Native American tribes
- Sept 9: Notice of public workshop posted
- Sept 14: Draft emergency regulations posted
- Sept 19: Public workshop held (150+ attendees)
- Sept 30: Written public comment period ended
- Oct 13: If CEC adopts, file with Office of Administrative Law

- Adopt sections 1875-1882 of California Code of Regulations, title 20, article 4.1
