## **Areas of Eastern Sierra not appropriate for wind or solar development**

To whom it may concern,

I would like to comment on the California Energy Commission's proposed locations for renewable energy projects. While I am generally in favor of renewable energy, I would ask that the CEC avoid the following areas when choosing potential sites for wind and/or solar projects:

- Any land that would result in the significant disturbance of wildlife, including but not limited to wetlands, migration corridors, flyways, nesting grounds, or areas where endangered or threatened species are found.
- Any lands that fall into established viewsheds, including but not limited to scenic overlooks and vistas, historic viewpoints, turn-outs, scenic highways, National Scenic Areas, California and National Cultural Heritage Sites, State and National Parks, public and private campgrounds.
- Any public lands where new roads would have to be constructed to reach or service the facility.
