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Prioritize wildlife restoration in land use screens

Rooftop solar has a lower ecosystem destruction footprint than solar farms. The disincentives for new rooftop solar adapters should be removed. We should prioritize ecosystem restoration over solar farms. Surely there are sites that are already industrial or bad candidates for ecosystem restoration that could be used.

There should be a cap on how many sites in a region can be developed. We need to keep our wildlife corridors and wetlands for carbon sequestration. Putting everything in one area cuts corridors.

Some remote sites are nowhere near existing grids or substations. Surely we can use sites near the existing grid?

The resource maps should exclude land that is currently in environmental easements.
