Notice of Consideration to Adopt Third Edition Guidelines for California Schools Healthy Air, Plumbing, and Efficiency Plumbing Program

As part of the California Energy Commission's (CEC) December 14, 2022, business meeting, the CEC will consider adoption of the *California Schools Healthy Air, Plumbing, and Efficiency (CalSHAPE) Plumbing Program Draft Commission Guidelines, Third Edition* (Third Edition Draft Guidelines).

Background

Assembly Bill 841 (Ting, Chapter 372, Statutes of 2020) enacted the School Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program, which is referred to as the CalSHAPE Program, and includes two grant programs: the CalSHAPE Ventilation Program and the CalSHAPE Plumbing Program. The CalSHAPE Ventilation Program provides funding to California schools to assess, maintain, and repair ventilation systems. The CalSHAPE Plumbing Program provides funding to California schools and state agencies to replace aging and inefficient plumbing fixtures and appliances with waterconserving plumbing fixtures and appliances. Both CalSHAPE Programs began accepting applications in the fall of 2021. The *CalSHAPE Plumbing Program Commission Guidelines, Second Edition* (Second Edition Guidelines) were approved by the CEC on June 8, 2022.

Third Edition Draft Guidelines

CEC staff has made modifications to the Third Edition Draft Guidelines for the CalSHAPE Plumbing Program. Both a clean and an underline/strikethrough version of the Third Edition Draft Guidelines are available for review and comment on the <u>CalSHAPE program page</u>, at https://www.energy.ca.gov/programs-and-topics/programs/california-schools-healthy-airplumbing-and-efficiency-program, or the <u>20-RENEW-01 docket</u>, at https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=20-RENEW-01. The modifications shown in the Third Edition Draft Guidelines were made to expand the eligibility to include state agencies, in accordance with Public Utilities Code Section 1631. The language changes to the Third Edition Draft Guidelines as compared to the Second Edition Guidelines (Adopted June 2022) are summarized below:

Abstract

• Modified language to expand eligibility to state agencies.

Adopted June 2022: The second edition of these guidelines addresses the initial phase of program awards, which is limited to local educational agencies, and incorporates changes to project eligibility.

Draft: The third edition of these guidelines expands the eligibility for program awards to include state agencies.

Chapter 1, Section A: Introduction

• Modified language to change "LEA" to "applicants."

Adopted June 2022: Notice of proposed award – CEC notification to the LEA following approval of a grant application.

Draft: Notice of proposed award – CEC notification to the applicant following approval of a grant application.

Adopted June 2022: Site – School where School Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Replacement Grant work will be performed.

Draft: Site – The physical location where Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Replacement Grant work will be performed.

- Added definition of state agency.

Adopted June 2022: (No definition)

Draft: State agency – Any agency, board, bureau, commission, department, office, or other division of the State of California, including the University of California, California State University, and California Community Colleges and the affiliated foundations acting on their behalf.

Chapter 1, Section C: Budget

• Modified language to correct Public Utilities Code (PUC) Section reference.

Adopted June 2022: Following PUC Section 1615(e), the CEC shall return all unused funds to each utility by December 1, 2026.

Draft: Following PUC Section 1615(f), the CEC shall return all unused funds to each utility by December 1, 2026.

Chapter 1, Section D: CalSHAPE Plumbing Eilgibility

• Modified language to change "schools" to "sites" or "projects."

Adopted June 2022: California LEAs may apply for funding to be used for projects at schools that are in the service territory of the utilities as defined herein.

Draft: Applicants may apply for funding to be used for projects at sites that are in the service territory of the utilities as defined herein.

- Appendix A

Chapter 1, Section E: Schools in Underserved Communities

• Removed language on priority awards.

Adopted June 2022: Beginning with the start of Funding Round Three, the CEC will no longer offer priority awards to schools in underserved communities but reserves the right to limit eligibility to achieve statutory and other goals. The CEC will continue to identify sites that meet the criteria for underserved communities, listed above, for data collection purposes and to verify that statutory requirements are met.

Draft: (Language removed)

Chapter 2, Section I: Project Term

• Modified language to change "LEA" or "applicant" to "grantee."

Adopted June 2022: For each School Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Replacement Grant project, the LEA will have up to 24 months to complete all work and submit the final documentation described in Chapter 4.

Draft: For each Plumbing Fixture and Appliance Replacement Grant project, the grantee will have up to 24 months to complete all work and submit the final documentation described in Chapter 4.

Chapter 3: Grant Applications and Awards

• Added language on contents of notice of funding availability.

Adopted June 2022: Dates may be adjusted by the CEC through the issuance of a notice updating information.

Draft: When issuing a notice of funding availability, CEC reserves the right to limit eligibility, or include a priority application period or other funding restrictions, to achieve the program's statutory or other goals. Dates, eligibility, and other details may be adjusted by the CEC through the issuance of a notice updating information.

Chapter 3, Section B: Application Package

• Modified language to generalized description of plan review, approval and permitting requirements.

Adopted June 2022: It will obtain Division of the State Architect (DSA) project approval as applicable under California Code Regulations, Title 24.

Draft: It will comply with applicable standards and requirements and obtain any required project plan review, approval, or building permits.

 - Chapter 4 Section C
 - Chapter 5 Section D
