








Legislative Drivers



California Department of Water Resources (DWR)

Tasked to deploy and manage additional energy resources to safeguard the State's energy grid through a newly created Strategic Reliability Reserve





California Benefits from Electricity Supply Strategic Reliability Reserve

- Acts as insurance policy and safeguards the statewide electrical grid
- Provides additional energy reserves during extreme and combined events (heat waves, wildfires, and droughts)
- Helps to avoid power shortages and outages for millions of Californians
- Supports California's transition to a clean energy future



DWR's Role

- Identify, prioritize and select new generation projects
- Develop/execute contracts and oversee engineering, procurement and construction of projects
- Implement state certification and environmental compliance
- Administer Electricity Supply Strategic Reliability Reserve Fund
- Coordinate with State agencies (CAISO, CARB, CEC, CPUC, SWRCB, etc.) and report progress


