Dear Michael A. Hyams:

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has received CleanPowerSF's (applicant) Application for Confidentiality docketed September 9, 2022, (TN 245958), covering the following data:

The applicant states that such data should be designated confidential for a three-

year forecast period until December 31, 2025, for its resource adequacy-related information and a two-year forecast period for Renewables Portfolio Standard (RPS) related information. Additionally, the applicant requests that capacity information be confidential for ten years, to match the forecast period. The application cites Government Code sections 6254(k) and 6255(a) as the basis for confidentiality and asserts that data can be disclosed if aggregated with other similar data.

Under section 2505(b) the CEC shall designate the requested information confidential when the applicant seeks confidentiality as a federal, state, regional, or local agency or state-created private entity, which possesses information pertinent to the responsibilities of the CEC, that has been designated by applicant as confidential under the Public Records Act or the Freedom of Information Act.

Here, the applicant, CleanPowerSF, is a local agency and has designated that the data is confidential under the Public Records Act.

Therefore, the CEC designates the above-described information as confidential under Section 2505(b) for the requested term of three years for Resource Adequacy data and two years for RPS data. Capacity data will also be confidential for three years. Data may be disclosed if aggregated with data from other load-serving entities.

Be advised that under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2506, one may petition to inspect or copy records that the CEC has designated as confidential. A decision on a petition to inspect or copy records is issued by the CEC's chief counsel. Under California Code of Regulations, title 20, section 2507, the executive director may disclose, or release records previously designated as confidential in certain circumstances, and the CEC may hold a hearing to determine the confidentiality of its records on its own motion or on a motion by CEC staff. The procedures and criteria for disclosing or releasing, filing, reviewing, and acting upon such petitions or motions are set forth in California Code of Regulations, title 20, sections 2506-2508.
