The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop to solicit comments on California's evolving economic and demographic landscape. The workshop provides an opportunity for commissioners, energy demand forecasters, CEC staff, and stakeholders to obtain further insight on possible state economic outcomes. The information gained from this workshop will enhance the 2023 California Energy Demand Forecast.

This workshop is part of the 2023 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) proceeding. Commissioner Patty Monahan is the CEC's Lead Commissioner for the 2023 IEPR. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The public can participate consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The hearing may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

The workshop will include two panels of experts, the first will discuss California's economic and demographic outlook and the second will address the market outlook for electrification technology. A moderator will pose questions to each panel regarding major economic and demographic issues.

The morning session will include a panel comprised of demographers and economists with both state and regional expertise. The panelists will discuss California's economic projections and California's changing population.

The afternoon session will include a panel of experts in electrification and decarbonization technology markets. Such technologies include zero-emission vehicles, heat pumps, battery storage, and carbon capture. Topics could span the availability and advancement of technologies, impacts from the Inflation Recovery Act and other incentives, manufacturing, and supply chains.

There will be an opportunity for public comment at the end of the workshop.

Background

California Public Resources Code Section 25301 requires the CEC to prepare an IEPR every two years that includes assessments and forecasts of energy industry supply, production, transportation, delivery and distribution, demand, and prices. The CEC develops these assessments and forecasts of the state's electricity and pipeline gas markets, including statewide and regional electricity and gas demand, incorporating factors leading to future demand growth, such as changes in economic activity, population growth, urban development, industrial expansion and energy intensity, growth in different building types, and energy and environmental policies.

Public Comment

The CEC encourages use of its electronic commenting system.
