We welcome changes to Quality Assurance

Vital to build trust and credibility to the HERS Program

Emphasize training *raters* while ending *rater company* culture of fraud and falsification



Concerns with the conflict of interest proposals:

Changes that increase costs and complexity will decreasing overall compliance with Title 24.

Limiting the competitiveness of small companies

Changes won't limit the actual conflicts of interest in the field



When the HERS program works:

Installer Training





Proposed Alternatives:

- Strengthen QA but make limited change to conflict of interest provisions
- 1. Expand Rater's role to enforce all elements of Title 24
- Incorporate HERS Raters into local AHJs



Other issues for consideration:

No issue on the naming convention but understand the concerns

Need to limit the removal of raters from a project

Need for consistent enforcement by AHJs

Need for commercial Title 24 enforcement
