The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote-access workshop to discuss workforce training and development topics, potential funding concepts, and proposed program activities for the CEC's Clean Transportation Program. The workshop will solicit public feedback and assess the status of the zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) and ZEV infrastructure industry and how investments and partnerships can be leveraged to support the needed workforce. A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the instructions provided below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

## **Background**

Assembly Bill (AB) 118 (Núñez, Chapter 750, Statutes of 2007), created the Clean Transportation Program. The statute authorizes the CEC to develop and deploy alternative and renewable fuels and advanced transportation technologies to help attain the state's climate change and clean air goals. AB 8 (Perea, Chapter 401, Statutes of 2013) reauthorized the funding program to January 1, 2024.

The Clean Transportation Program's annual investment plans identify funding for workforce training and development activities. There is currently \$9 million in approved funding for workforce activities, with \$5 million preliminarily identified as potential funding from a future Clean Transportation Program Investment Plan.

AB 841 (Ting, Chapter 372, Statutes of 2020) requires Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Training Program (EVITP) training and certification for certain electric vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure and equipment installations. State agency-funded EV charger installation projects shall be installed by a contractor with the appropriate license classification,<sup>1</sup> and at least one electrician on each crew, at any given time, must hold an EVITP certification.
