### California Benefits from Electricity Supply Strategic Reliability Reserve

- Acts as insurance policy and safeguards the statewide electrical grid
- Provides additional energy reserves during extreme and combined events (heat events, wildfires, and drought)
- Helps to avoid power shortages and outages for millions of Californians
- Supports California's transition to a clean energy future



#### DWR's Role

- Identify, prioritize and select new generation projects
- Develop/execute contracts and oversee engineering, procurement and construction of projects
- Implement state certification and environmental compliance
- Administer Electricity Supply Reliability Reserve Fund
- Coordinate with State agencies (CARB, CEC, CPUC, SWRCB, etc.) and CAISO and report progress


