The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a workshop in collaboration with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and the California Independent System Operator (CAISO) to present and seek comments from stakeholders and interested parties on the preliminary load shift goal and forthcoming preliminary report to reduce net peak electrical demand as required by Senate Bill 846, Dodd, 2022 (SB 846). A quorum of CEC commissioners, CPUC commissioners, and CAISO board members may participate, but no votes will be taken. If CPUC commissioners are present at the workshop, the CPUC's rules governing ex parte contacts with commissioners and their staff remain in effect even though this is a CEC-initiated and noticed workshop.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

## **Agenda**

CEC staff will present an overview of the preliminary load shift goal that was developed in consultation with and with input from the CPUC and the CAISO staff. The workshop will include a public comment period.

## **Background**

SB 846 creates the option to extend the operation of Diablo Canyon Nuclear Power Plant for five years beyond the currently scheduled retirement date of 2025. This bill also enables the state to provide additional resources to support grid reliability, while building out new clean energy

resources, including through the Clean Energy Reliability Investment Plan. SB 846 also directs the CEC to establish, in consultation with the CPUC and CAISO, a load shift goal that focuses on reducing net peak electrical demand and a report that includes recommended policies to increase demand response and load shifting without increasing greenhouse gas emissions or electricity rates. (Public Resources Code section 25302.7) This load shift goal must be adopted by June 1, 2023, and is to be adjusted in each biennial Integrated Energy Policy Report thereafter.
