Agenda

This webinar will feature two CEC presentations on preliminary natural gas price modeling results. In the first presentation, CEC staff will cover updates to the 2023 NAMGas model and share the preliminary gas commodity hub price results. The second presentation will discuss how the enduse price models build upon NAMGas results and accounts for gas transportation costs to form "delivered" rates. Workshop participants will have the opportunity to ask questions after each presentation. There will be a public comment period at the end of the webinar, including an opportunity to provide feedback regarding model assumptions and results.

Commodity and end-use price projections, as presented in this webinar, are an integral input to the California gas demand forecast. This webinar also provides a platform to coordinate with external gas stakeholders with the goal of improving the precision of the gas price models.
