But in 'Grid_Support_Inverter_List', the CEC efficiency is rounded with 0.5% interval with CEC staff. The result is same as the formula =

"&IF(ISNUMBER(J13),TEXT(INT(AVERAGE(J13,J14,J15)/IF(J13>1,100,1)*200+0.5)/200,"#.0%"),"")' which in the old 'Power_and_Efficiency_of_Inverter_Form'.

We are appreciate if these could be unified. So our product data sheet, 'Power_and_Efficiency_of_Inverter_Form' display, 'Grid_Support_Inverter_List', these 3 files could show the same 'CEC efficiency' value.

2. PV and battery hybrid inverter when listed in the 'Battery_Inverters' listing, maybe use the Battery to Grid efficiency is more suitable.
