## **Eligibility**

Living in San Diego County is expensive. Many of us living in multigenerational households to be able to pay our large mortgages and other debts. I got quotes last year for a heat pump and it was \$18k - \$28k for my 1,400sq ft house. Coming out of pocket to replace our gas furnace isn't something we have this much extra budget for. I hope the commission considers an income limit per married couple up around \$300k before the credit starts to phase out, making it available to all families (including ones that live in San Francisco and San Diego). I also hope the Commission decides and publishes the income brackets as soon as possible so people know whether to sweat it out another summer without AC or if there's no benefit to waiting due to qualification restrictions.
