The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a hybrid workshop to inform the public of the proposed plan to implement Senate Bill 2 (Skinner, Statutes of 2023, 1st Ex. Sess.) (SB 2) (formerly SBX1-2) with a focus on new transportation fuels data reporting requirements and the approach to the assessment to identify methods to ensure a reliable supply of affordable and safe transportation fuels in California.

A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

Staff will present an overview of the requirements of SB 2 and proposed implementation plan with a focus on the data requirements and approach to the assessment due to the legislature on January 1, 2024. Staff will discuss changes to existing forms and future data collection and statutory reporting requirements. Staff will present fuel demand scenarios to be assessed and discuss strategies to ensure adequate gasoline supplies and prevent future extreme price spikes for gasoline prices in California.

There will be multiple announced public comment periods at the workshop and written comments will be accepted for the period identified below following the workshop.

Background

SB 2, approved by the Governor on March 28, 2023, gives the CEC the authority to set a maximum gross gasoline refining margin and to impose an administrative civil penalty on a refiner for exceeding that margin. SB 2 also establishes the Division of Petroleum Market Oversight and the Independent Consumer Fuels Advisory Committee to provide guidance and recommendations to the Governor and the commission on any issues related to transportation fuels pricing and transportation decarbonization in California. The bill contains several CEC reporting requirements, including:

- An annual report prepared in cooperation with the California Department of Tax and Fee Administration that includes a review of the price of gasoline in California and its impact on state revenues for the previous calendar year.
- A triennial assessment that identifies methods to ensure a reliable supply of affordable and safe transportation fuels in California.
- A Transportation Fuels Transition Plan prepared with the State Air Resources Board.

SB 2 revises and introduces several new petroleum industry reporting requirements, with submittals beginning in July 2023. The new information to be reported includes spot market transactions, firm ownership, agreements and contracts, inventory holdings by type, refinery maintenance schedules, 96-hour notice of marine vessel imports, expanded refinery operator reporting, and new pipeline and port operator reporting.
