General Takeaways So Far

Formula opportunities:

- Time consuming, but reasonable.
- Federal hand-holding available.

Competitive opportunities:

- Extremely resource intensive if CEC leading large, complex application with many project partners
- Easier if CEC effectively hands off to project partner to put application together



Supporting Others

Cost share Solicitations

- Seem to be working
- Timing requirements are very challenging for applicants.
- EPIC Cost-Share Request: Pre-Qualify Opportunities

Letters of Support

- Random requests
- Not requested by all CA entities going for same opportunity.



What the CEC Could Improve

Federal Liaison

- someone to ask questions, navigate solutions for all project teams.
- Coordinate with CNRA or GO federal liaisons.

Support Contracts

- Grant writing consultant for competitive applications
 - Experience with federal funding is key
 - Surprisingly resource intensive
- Contractor to administer federal funds
 - Significant federal compliance/reporting requirements
 - Research has been done, need to implement.
- Contracts should be broadly-scoped, like Siting's Aspen contract.
- Audit staff dedicated to federal funding compliance efforts



What is CA missing?

- Statewide infrastructure planning
 - Identify priority projects for competitive applications
 - Map related statewide efforts. Need clear view of who is doing what.
 - Outreach team to identify what private sector is applying for and how state can support
- CA appears to be starting these efforts
 - Leadership structure not clear
 - Likely behind smaller states with less complicated bureaucracy



What is CA missing?

- State Agency Application/Grant Management Support
 - Need grant writers
 - Need federal compliance contractors
 - Contracting process too time consuming; requirements too limiting.
 - Statewide option: considering contracts through universities.
- Federal match funding flexibility
 - Competitive limitations on funding sources make inaccessible as match.
 - o CEC-wide Trailer bill language denied.
 - Trying to target key funding sources: DEBA.
