# PROPOSED REVISIONS TO THE AMENDMENTS OF THE HOME ENERGY RATING SYSTEM (HERS) REGULATIONS

## California Energy Commission Docket No. 23-HERS-01

On February 9, 2023, the California Energy Commission (CEC) published a Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) with proposed amendments to the HERS regulations in Title 20 of the California Code of Regulations. The CEC made documents available for a 45-day comment period ending March 27, 2023, and held a public hearing on March 28, 2023.

Based on comments received during the written comment period and the public hearing, the CEC is proposing changes to the proposed amendments shared on February 9, 2023. Any interested persons are invited to review and provide written comments to the CEC for consideration during the 15-day comment period from June 1, 2023, through June 16, 2023. The CEC appreciates receiving written comments at the earliest possible date. Comments submitted after June 16, 2023, are considered untimely and the CEC may, but is not required to, respond to untimely comments, including those raising significant environmental issues.

### **Summary of Proposed Modifications**

The following summary does not include all modifications to correct typographical or grammatical errors, changes in numbering or formatting, nor does it include all the non-substantive revisions made to improve clarity.

### 1. Modifications to all sections

CEC amended the effective date language in all sections to specify the current regulations for the field verification and diagnostic testing program in Title 20 will remain in effect until new regulations for the field verification and diagnostic testing program are established and become effective in Title 24 of the California Code of Regulations. This change was made to alleviate public concerns that the field verification and diagnostic testing program could be eliminated if the Title 24 changes do not happen by January 1, 2026.
