Retroactive rebates for Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)-qualifying Heat Pump system

Dear CEC Representative,

I've recently been in contact with CEC employees regarding IRA rebates. In one conversation, I was told that IRA rebate program details are not yet finalized and therefore IRA-qualifying projects completed in early 2023 will not be eligible for those rebates. As has been urged in the dozens of comments received by the CEC regarding the IRA rebate issue, these rebates should be made retroactive for all of 2023 considering IRA was enacted in 2022 and its provisions became law on January 1, 2023. Not making these rebates retroactive is essentially punishing early adopters of energy-efficiency technologies. Early adopters of energy-efficiency technologies should be rewarded not punished.
