Webinar on AB 525 Strategic Plan: Identifying Additional Suitable Sea Space and Assessing Impacts and Mitigations for Offshore Wind Energy Development

On June 1, 2023, the California Energy Commission (CEC) hosted a workshop focused on the requirements established in Assembly Bill 525 (Chiu, Chapter 231, Statutes of 2021) (AB 525) to identify suitable sea space for wind energy areas in federal waters sufficient to accommodate the offshore wind planning goals established for 2030 and 2045. The workshop also included an overview of potential impacts and mitigations for addressing those impacts.
