SB 846 requires the CEC to present a cost comparison of extending the DCPP to a portfolio of other feasible resources available for calendar years 2024 to 2035. The portfolio should be consistent with the greenhouse gas emissions reductions goals of Section 454.53 of the Public Utilities Code. The report is due to the legislature by September 30, 2023.
