The California Energy Commission (CEC), California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) and California Air Resources Board (CARB) will conduct a joint workshop to present and discuss the analytical framework for the Senate Bill 100 (SB 100) Joint Agency Report. This framework will be used to analyze pathways to achieving the SB 100 targets of 100 percent clean electricity by 2045. The results of the modeling effort and pathway tradeoffs will be assessed in the 2025 SB 100 Joint Agency Report. A quorum of commissioners or members from the CEC, California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and the California Air Resources Board (CARB) may participate, but no votes will be taken.

**Agenda**

Staff will present the analytical framework for the pathways that will be modeled for SB 100, including preliminary data sources for inputs and assumptions. Members of the dais will have the

opportunity to ask questions of staff and comment on the proposed analytical framework and approach to inputs and assumptions, followed by a public comment period.

## **Background**

SB 100 requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to complete a joint agency report to the Legislature evaluating the 100 percent zero-carbon electricity policy. The requirement is codified in the [Public Utilities Code section 454.53](https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53), and the full text is available at [https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes\\_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53](https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53).

The [2021 SB 100 Joint Agency Report, available at https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/EFiling/GetFile.aspx?tn=237167&DocumentContentId=70349](https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/EFiling/GetFile.aspx?tn=237167&DocumentContentId=70349), was published March 15, 2021, and was a first step to evaluate the challenges and opportunities in implementing SB 100. It included an initial assessment of the additional energy resources and the resource building rates needed to achieve 100 percent clean electricity, along with the associated costs. The next SB 100 Joint Agency Report is due to the legislature on January 1, 2025.
