STATEMENT OF STAFF APPROVAL CHANGE IN OWNERSHIP AND OPERATIONAL CONTROL

ALLIANCE CENTURY ENERGY FACILITY (01-EP-04C)

On September 29, 2023, the Colton Power, L.P., the project owner, filed a post certification petition with the California Energy Commission (CEC) requesting to transfer operational control of the Alliance Century Energy Facility (ACEF) from Alliance Energy Marketing, LLC to Colton Power, L.P. The petition also serves as notification of the project name change from Alliance Century Energy Facility to Century Energy Facility.

The 40-megawatt project was certified by the CEC on April 25, 2001 and began commercial operation on September 15, 2001. The ACEF is located in the City of Colton in San Bernardino County.

A statement describing the change in ownership and operational control, signed under penalty of perjury by an officer of Colton Power, L.P., was submitted pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 20, sections 1769(b) and 1707. The statement affirms that the Colton Power, L.P. understands the conditions of certification in the Commission Decision or as previously amended and agrees to comply with those conditions.

Staff has reviewed the petition and has determined that the petition meets the requirements of California Code of Regulations, Title 20, section 1769(b). Accordingly, staff hereby approves the petition to change ownership and operational control for ACEF.
