The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a pre-rulemaking workshop to inform the public of the proposed rulemaking to implement provisions of Senate Bill X1-2 (Stats. 2023, 1st Ex. Sess. 2023, ch. 1) and Senate Bill (SB) 1322 (Stats. 2022, ch. 374) on topics including, but not limited to, rules related to the data collection and analysis provisions in Public Resources Code (PRC) section 25354 and rules to manage necessary refinery maintenance and turnarounds pursuant to PRC section 25354.2.

A quorum of commissioners may participate, but no votes will be taken.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

This workshop will initiate discussions about possible amendments to existing CEC regulations and guidelines associated with the Petroleum Industry Information Reporting Act (PIIRA), (Title 20, Division 2, Chapter 3, Article 3) to cover new statutory provisions resulting from the passage of SB X1-2 and SB 1322. SB X1-2 increased the data collection and analysis provisions in Public Resources Code section 25354 and includes new provisions for the CEC to develop rules to manage necessary refinery maintenance and turnarounds pursuant to Public Resources Code

section 25354.2. SB 1322 added new data collection and publication requirements regarding refiner margins. Additional rules for other aspects of Public Resources Code 25354 and 25355 will also be considered for data collection purposes. A separate rulemaking proceeding for additional clarifying regulations on other aspects of the Senate Bill X1-2 could also be initiated in the future if that need is determined.

Staff will provide an overview of planned rulemaking activities under the proceeding, an overview of the topics to be covered in the rulemaking proceeding, including possible clarification on the required data elements for spot market transactions, refiner maintenance, refiner costs, shipping reports, and formats for data submission. CEC staff will also discuss possible rulemaking to support a process to manage maintenance turnarounds. CEC staff will also seek input on additional activities and clarifications that should be made through this rulemaking proceeding.

Background

SB X1-2, approved by the Governor on March 28, 2023, revised and introduced several new petroleum industry reporting requirements, with submittals beginning in July 2023. The new information includes spot market transactions, firm ownership, agreements and contracts, inventory holdings by type, refinery maintenance schedules, 96-hour notice of marine vessel imports, expanded refinery operator reporting, and new pipeline and port operator reporting. SB X1-2 also authorized the CEC to regulate the timing of refinery maintenance and turnaround.

Additionally, among other changes, SB X1-2 authorized the CEC to set a maximum gross gasoline refining margin and to impose an administrative civil penalty on a refiner for exceeding that margin, which the CEC is considering in a separate proceeding under Docket No. <u>23-OIIP-01</u>. The legislation also established the Division of Petroleum Market Oversight and the Independent Consumer Fuels Advisory Committee to provide guidance and recommendations to the Governor and the commission on any issues related to transportation fuels pricing and transportation decarbonization in California.

SB 1322 added data reporting requirements regarding refiner margins and requires the CEC to post certain information about refiner margins on the CEC website.
