The most recent version of ASHRAE 62.2 is 2022 with addenda d, e, i, k, and m. This version contains numerous clarifications, including: (1) requirements for ventilation rate, control, and operation are now easier to follow, enforce, and maintain over time; (2) new definition of "readily accessible" and "accessible" is consistent with 2020 NEC and less ambiguous; (3) clarifies the requirements for installation and operation; (4) requires a supply or balanced mechanical ventilation system where new multifamily dwelling units are accessed by an enclosed common corridor; (5) removes the option of providing an openable window in place of mechanical exhaust within toilet rooms for new construction, consistent with new understandings of hazardous bioaerosols from human waste; (6) sets ozone emission limits for air cleaners.
