## F01 Turbine










Shadow Flicker Model

# Conextgen's stated benefits of Fountain Wind

### Monetary Benefits for Shasta County and Others

- \$3.5 million in sales tax revenue during construction (say \$1 million/year during const.)
- \$1,000,000 for the Shasta County Sheriff's Office
- \$100,000 to the Western Shasta Resource Conservation District and Shasta County Fire Safe Council
- \$1 million investment in the Round Mountain and Montgomery Creek communities.
- \$50 million in property tax revenue over 30 years (\$1.67million/year)
- \$250,000 Pit River Tribes
  - ~ \$3.3 mil (year 1), \$2.67 mil (years 2-4), \$1.67 mil (years 5-30)
  - Shasta County Yearly Operating Budget \$569,000,000

Equates to 1/2% - 1/3% of Shasta County's Yearly Operating Budget Proverbial "Drop in the Bucket"
