## **Rebate amounts and timeline Income verification**

In my view the use of SSA and IRS documentation would provide the CEC with a good deal of the information needed for income verification and provide low income residents with a less difficult path to acquiring the necessary rebate assistance. Fixed cost method I believe would be preferable. The measured pathway method will be very labor intensive and costly to implement. Depending on income levels a higher refundable amount should be available to the lowest income residents.
