The California Energy Commission (CEC), the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and the California Air Resources Board (CARB) will conduct a joint workshop to discuss approaches for examining the environmental and land use implications of potential resource scenarios to meet Senate Bill 100 (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) targets.

This is a hybrid meeting with both a publicly accessible physical location and public access online or by phone through $\mathsf{Zoom}^{\mathsf{TM}}$. A majority of commissioners may participate in person, but no votes will be taken.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is estimated based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

The workshop will focus on approaches to incorporating environmental and land use implications of potential resource scenarios into the SB 100 analysis. There will be presentations by CEC, CPUC, and CARB covering land use considerations in energy resource and climate planning (AB 32 Scoping Plan), and proposed goals and approaches to evaluating land use in the 2025 SB 100 Report. Representatives from California Native American tribes will participate in a panel on considerations for cultural resources in energy planning. Representatives from government will participate in a panel on coordination to achieve SB 100. Representatives from industry, local governments, and environmental groups will participate in a panel on land use and SB 100 implementation.

Background

The 100 Percent Clean Energy Act of 2018 (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) establishes a target for renewable and zero-carbon resources to supply 100 percent of retail sales and electricity procured to serve all state agencies by 2045. SB 100 requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to develop and submit a joint-agency report to the legislature by January 1, 2021, and at least every four years thereafter. The requirement is codified in the Public Utilities Code Section 454.53, and the full text is available at

https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC§ionNum=4 54.53.

The 2021 SB 100 Joint Agency Report, available at

https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/EFiling/GetFile.aspx?tn=237167&DocumentContentId=70349, published March 15, 2021, makes several land-use-related recommendations: (1) analyze projected land-use impacts of scenarios and opportunities to reduce environmental impacts in future analyses; (2) include non-energy benefits, such as land use impacts; and (3) coordinate future system modeling and land-use impacts with the Climate Smart Strategy called for in Executive Order N-82-20 and the AB 32 Scoping Plan (https://ww2.arb.ca.gov/our-work/programs/ab-32-climate-change-scoping-plan).
