## Expand scope

I encourage you to expand the scope of Group 2 to focus on interventions and the application of existing sensors, in addition to sensor development. Sensor development is highly specialized and specific to distinct air pollutants: a sensor for one pollutant (e.g., particulate matter) will not work for another (e.g., NOx). There is no such thing as an "air quality sensor." There are existing sensors for particulate matter that are generally sufficient to assess the utility of interventions, and new sensor development is not really necessary in this area. Sensor development in other areas requires a need to specify which pollutants are of particular interest. The focus should be on application of existing sensor technology in ways that can help assess household air pollution and improvements achieved through targeted interventions.
