The Information should be kept confidential in its entirety as it contains sensitive information regarding the location of certain paleontological resources.

The Information should be held confidential indefinitely in order to protect the paleontological resources identified therein.

The Paleontological Resources Preservation Act of 2009 provides that "information concerning the nature and specific location of a paleontological resource shall be exempt from disclosure" under the Freedom of Information Act and any other law, unless otherwise determined by either the Secretary of the Interior or the Secretary of Agriculture. (16 U.S.C. §§ 470aaa-4, 470aaa-8.) The Applicant is unaware of any such determination for the resources described above.

Further, California Government Code Section 7922.000 provides that an agency may withhold information from disclosure where the public interest served by nondisclosure clearly outweighs the public interest of disclosure. The public interest in nondisclosure outweighs that of disclosure, as disclosure may enable the location of sensitive paleontological resources sites by entities conducting unauthorized collection or disturbance of such resources.

4. State whether the information may be disclosed if it is aggregated with other information or masked to conceal certain portions, and if so the degree of aggregation or masking required.

The Applicant considered whether it would be possible to aggregate or mask the information. It may be possible to disclose general information contained within Appendix 5.8A; however, the specific locational and other sensitive information should not be disclosed.

5. State whether and how the information is kept confidential by the applicant and whether it has ever been disclosed to a person other than an employee of the applicant, and if so under what circumstances.

The Information is accessible only to the Applicant's employees or consultants working on behalf of the WRESC, and regulatory agencies and other entities that have regulatory oversight or other responsibilities over either the Information or the WRESC.
