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In the, https://efiling.energy.ca.gov/Lists/DocketLog.aspx?docketnumber=17-MISC-01, I see no mention of the potential impact on the Sea Otters, that have found protection and comfort in Morro Bay Harbor. They are also a Major Tourist Attraction which is good for our economy. We need to Protect our Otters, Sea Lions and Harbor Seals. The dredging, construction, and necessary warehousing as well as berth requirements will also effect and displace other harbor recreational businesses.

The operations and maintenance center to be located in Morro Bay Harbor would require 300' wharf length and 20-30' harbor depth, as well as multiple boat berths. There was no mention of any Research done on the impact of High Resolution Geographical Mapping, HRG.

Or the effects of High Level EMF's and the affect from the floating cables on Marine Life, Local Aquatic Habitat, and Fisheries.

There are too many Unanswered Questions to just randomly commit to the destruction of Morro Bay Harbor Life, as well as to the Migratory and Feeding Habitat that We Protect.
