Further, the public interest served in nondisclosure, protection of cultural resources, outweighs that of disclosure. Disclosing the Information may enable location of sensitive cultural resources by thieves, vandals, or persons conducting unauthorized collection of materials.

The Applicant considered whether it would be possible to aggregate or mask portions of Appendix A to the PTA Appendix E, and it may be possible to aggregate or redact certain portions.
