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## **ACM Manuals need to require a PROJECT NOTES section in all performance software**

Please make sure that all versions of all performance software always include a "Project Notes" input box. Such input box should be limited to no less than 1000 characters, and must appear in Certificate of Compliance Output. The location of its appearance can be either be immediately after the TDV / EDR results table(s) [toward the front of the Certificate of Compliance], or just before the signature blocks [at the end of the reported data]. This freely editable input should be reported regardless of the scope of the Certificate of Compliance (e.g. Envelope only, Mechanical only, etc.). This is perhaps the only way for energy consultants to directly communicate with plancheckers at the building permit application stage, and can go a long way towards eliminating unstudied / unnecessary plancheck comments.
