Hydrogen Funding Lane

The Hydrogen lane provides funding opportunities to hydrogen infrastructure projects. The application process is competitive, and applications are prioritized by project readiness, cost effectiveness, and community benefit.



When can I apply?

- Funding window: Opens April 17, 2024 at 9am Pacific Time (PT), closes May 1, 2024 at 5pm PT in the [IPC Application Portal](#).



What is covered?

Incentive Structure	Incentive Structure if Meeting Equity Criteria
50% of adjusted project costs	75% of adjusted project costs
\$3 million maximum award	\$4 million maximum award

What projects are eligible?



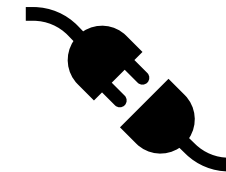
- Projects must be for hydrogen fuel cell MDHD infrastructure only.
- Refueling stations must be capable of dispensing 350 or 700 bar and be certified to SAE, ASME, ASTM, and NFPA standards.
- Projects may be private, public, or shared.

Eligibility



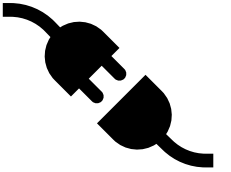
- **Applicant Eligibility:**

- Applicant team must have at least one of the following: a fleet, Fueling-as-a Service (FaaS) provider, site owner, authorized lessee, or an authorized representative of a site where MDHD ZEV infrastructure will be installed.
- Applicant must be in good standing with the Secretary of State (if required to register)
- A single entity, as identified by the Recipient tax identification number (TIN), cannot be awarded more than 25 percent of the total funding available for this lane.

- **Eligible Costs:**

- **Equipment:**
 - Dispenser with hose and nozzles
 - Compressors
 - Liquid and gaseous hydrogen pumps
 - Hydrogen storage
- **Software:**
 - Networking
 - Fleet/demand management
- **Maintenance and Warranty** may be listed but will not be added as eligible costs to the conditional award amount until final review.

Jump Start Equity Criteria



If any of the following apply to the project, it is eligible for the increased incentive:

- Charging infrastructure is in a designated Disadvantaged Community (DAC) or Low-Income Community (LIC).*
- Tribe or tribal-serving entity.
- Small business as identified in the California State Legislative Code.
- Certified Minority Business Enterprise, Woman-Owned Small Business, Veteran-Owned Small Business, or LGBT-Owned Small Business.
- Transit system with at least 50% of applicable routes or coverage areas within a DAC or LIC.*
- School district in a designated DAC or LIC or serving economically disadvantaged students.*
- Non-profit organization.

* DAC and LIC Designations can be found on the [California Climate Investments Priority Populations 2023 Map](#)

Charging/Fueling as a Service (C/FaaS)

- **Definition:**
 - EnergIIZE will accept Fueling as a Service applications during the Hydrogen lane.
 - A general term which applies to developers who build, own, and maintain ZEV Infrastructure on behalf of a fleet.
 - This business model varies, but it typically provides a turn-key solution for equipment, installation, software, site maintenance, and/or driver support for an agreed-upon recurring fee.
 - Service may be onsite or offsite relative to the fleet's primary business address.
 - ZEV infrastructure must support MDHD fleets.

Requirements per Application Section

Basic Details, Recipient, Project Partner, Project Site, Readiness Questions

- ✓ Answer Readiness Questions (do not count toward scoring)
- ✓ Contact Phone and Email of Recipient, Primary Application Contact, and Job Site Contact
- ✓ Estimated Total Project Cost
- ✓ Project details for intended service category and vehicle type and class
- ✓ Primary Contact Phone and Email of Project Partner
- ✓ Address and square footage of Infrastructure Project Site

Cost Share

- ✓ Disclosure of all funding sources awarded. This may include:
 - ✓ Notices of proposed award
 - ✓ Notice of grant award
 - ✓ Other official documentation indicating an award of funding
- ✓ Demonstrated proof-of-cost coverage for any non-incentivized project costs
- ✓ The sum of make-ready funding, self-contributions, other external funding sources
- ✓ **Note: EnerGIZE funding cannot be stacked with other active California Energy Commission funding programs. But you can stack with other programs!**

Requirements per Application Section

Site Equipment Manifest

- ✓ Preliminary Quotes of Equipment Necessary to Complete Project
- ✓ Make, Model, and Anticipated Quantity of Eligible Equipment to be Installed
- ✓ Labor Costs (**not** eligible for incentives through Hydrogen)

Qualitative Questions

- ✓ Provide answers to six qualitative questions, which will assess:
 - ✓ Project readiness
 - ✓ Community engagement and benefit
 - ✓ Project team's experience with hydrogen
- ✓ Upload supporting documentation and photos as necessary
- ✓ **Concise answers that address all criteria will contribute to a high score!**

Requirements per Application Section

Documents

- ✓ Site Verification Form*
- ✓ Preliminary Site Plans
- ✓ Confirmation of Request for Service from the local utility, notice that project site is being assessed for energy load capacity, or evidence of communication with the utility
- ✓ Proof of completion of Critical Milestone 1*
- ✓ Jump Start Certification Form (if project meets equity criteria)*

Read and acknowledge the Sample EnerglIZE Incentive Recipient Agreement and the EVITP, DIR, & Insurance Affidavit



Application Sandbox

- The EnerglIZE application process includes a sandbox testing environment
- The sandbox gives applicants an opportunity to interact with the application before applying
- **NOTE: The application sandbox will not save or store any data. The application fields will not be stored and will not auto-populate when the lane opening occurs. The sandbox is only intended to familiarize participants with the IPC.**

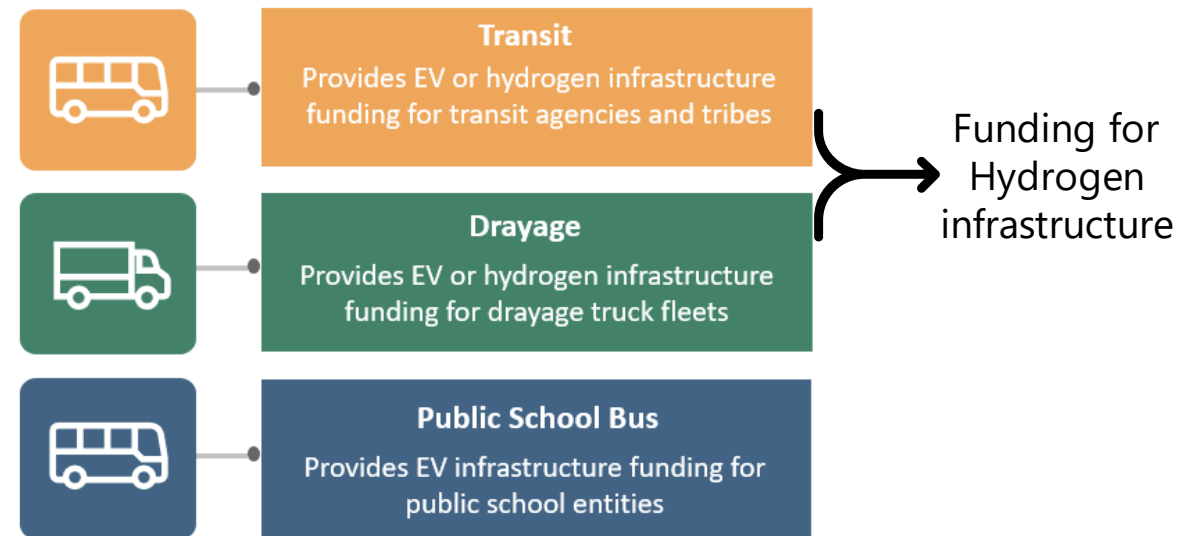
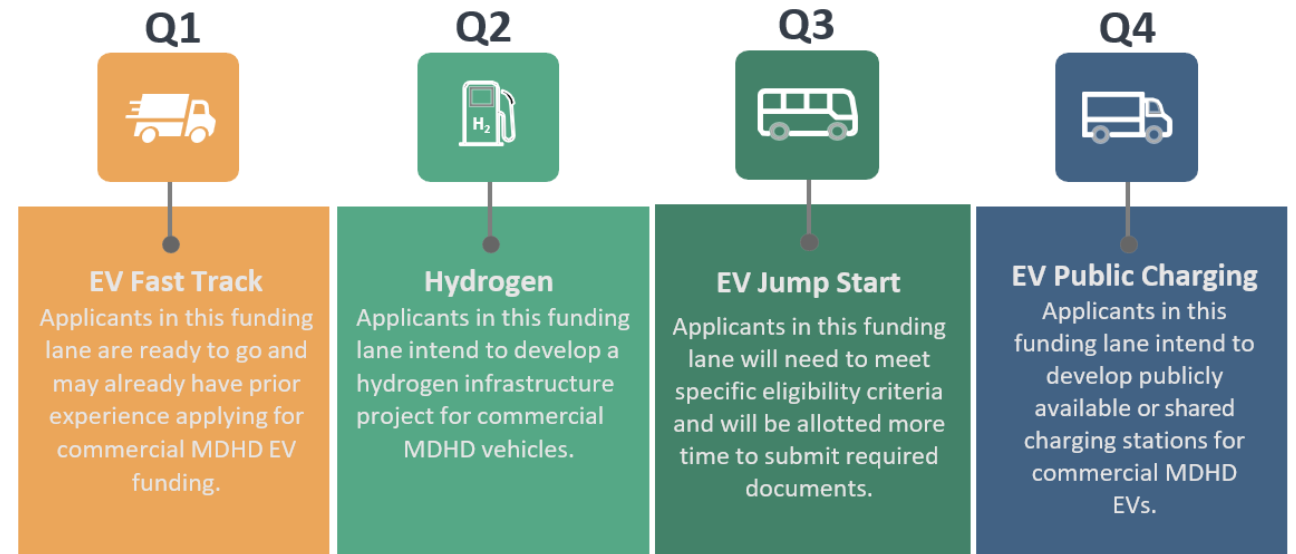

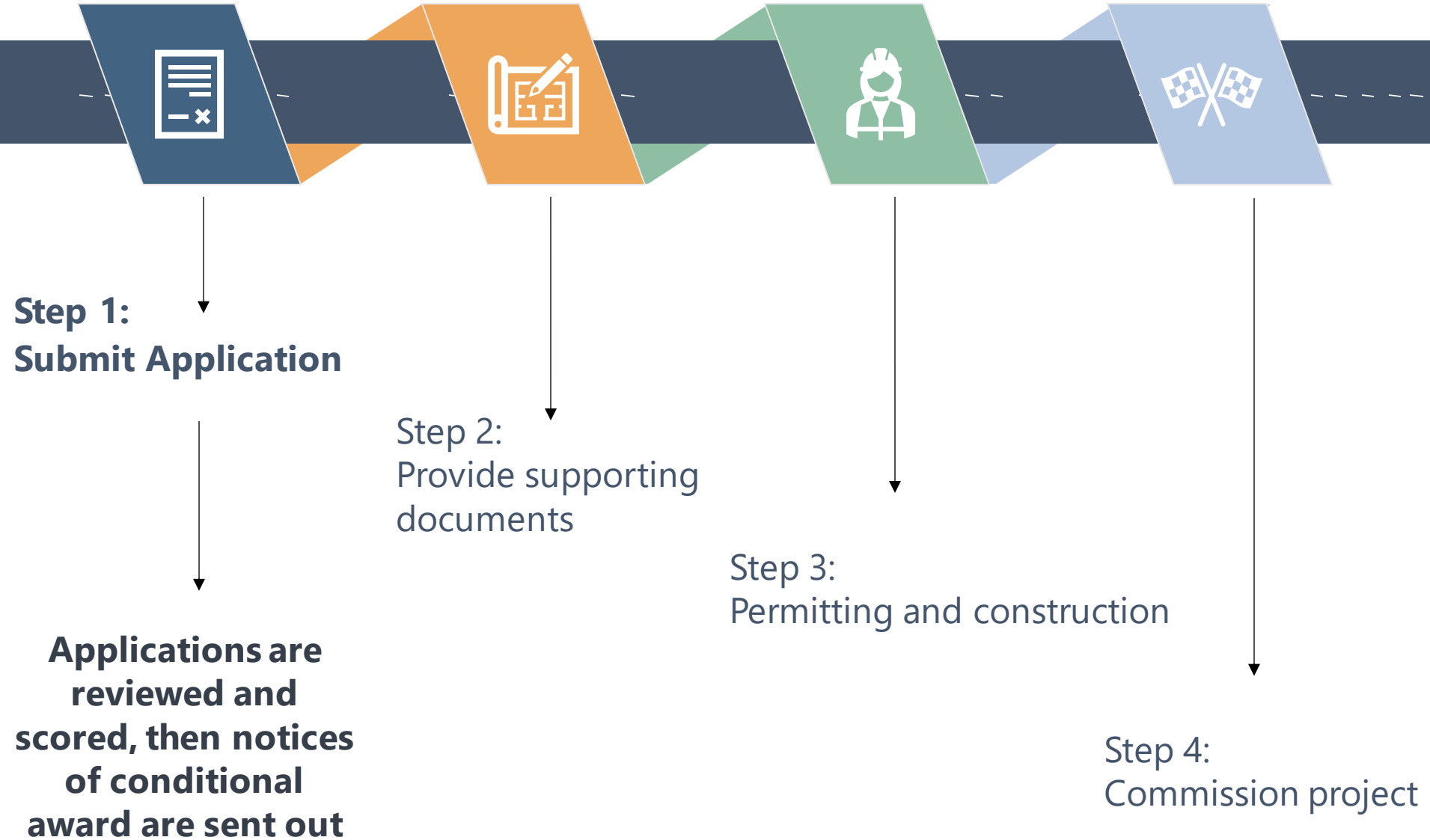

A: Once Hydrogen applicants have been provided with their notice of conditional award after completion of Step 1, they will then have 90 calendar days to provide the information in Step 2.

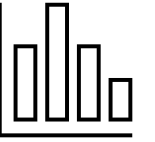

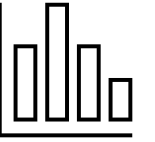
