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## **Draft Senate Bill 846 Diablo Canyon Power Plant Extension Cost Comparison**

The Energy commission is in violation of SB 846 which requires the CEC to file a FINAL Senate Bill 846 Diablo Canyon Power Plant Extension Cost Comparison by September 30, 2023. The final report was supposed to be filed six months ago. In addition the CEC is as a member of the Tracking Energy Development Task Force which has not provided an update since May of 2023. The energy commission also needs to update the Diablo Canyon Power Plant Extension – CEC Analysis of Need to Support Reliability as it is no longer valid. As CAISO reports as of the end of February 2024 we now have 7,261 MW of battery storage and have also added as of May 26, 2023 3,652 MW of Solar, 998 MW of Solar hybrid, 700 MW of Wind, and 41 MW of geothermal. The state has also delayed the retirement of 1,477 MW of once through cooling power plants and increased imports by 1,689 MW all of which is not included in your reliability analysis. Are these delays intentional? You are violating the law. (SB 846)
