Dear Government Reporting Specialist (Marine Import Reporters):

The California Energy Commission (CEC) has prepared a new marine import form. Effective June 17, 2024 (seven days after notice), we require that all importers of refined products and renewable fuels via marine vessels use the new form pursuant to Public Resources Code section 25354(j).

The Marine Import Report form (EBR700) replaces the 96 Hour Planned Import Report form (W700_96j). The EBR700 is required of importers of both foreign and domestic refined and renewable products at least 96 hours before the arrival of a marine vessel delivery to California. This new form requires more detail on import markets that supply the marginal barrel of product to California.
