The California Energy Commission (CEC), the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC), and the California Air Resources Board (CARB) will conduct a joint workshop to discuss utilities' progress on meeting Senate Bill 100's (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) statutory targets.

This is a virtual meeting, with public access online or by phone through Webex.

The public can participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The joint agencies aim to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is estimated based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

**Agenda**

The workshop will focus on the efforts that the state's utilities are taking to meet SB 100 targets. There will be presentations by CARB, CEC, and CPUC staff that will cover the Scoping Plan, the Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) demand forecast, and Integrated Resource Planning (IRP) and resource development trends, respectively. Representatives from the utilities and/or their

affiliated trade organizations, as well as from the Balancing Authorities will participate in panels and provide presentations.

### **Background**

The 100 Percent Clean Energy Act of 2018 (SB 100, De León, Chapter 312, Statutes of 2018) established a target for renewable and zero-carbon resources to supply 100 percent of retail sales and electricity procured to serve all state agencies by 2045. SB 100 requires the CEC, CPUC, and CARB to develop and submit a joint-agency report to the legislature by January 1, 2021, and at least every four years thereafter. The requirement is codified in the [Public Utilities Code Section 454.53](#), and the full text is available at [https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes\\_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53](https://leginfo.legislature.ca.gov/faces/codes_displaySection.xhtml?lawCode=PUC&sectionNum=454.53).
