Demand Scenarios Project Role

- The California Energy Commission initiated this Project during the 2021 Integrated Energy Policy Report (IEPR) cycle, with initial public engagement on the December 2, 2021, IEPR Workshop.
- The analysis, scenarios, and results were presented publicly in a workshop on April 7, 2022.
- Demand scenarios provide assessments primarily using CEC forecasting tools and methods.
- These assessments contribute to understanding implementation challenges of meeting statutory GHG emission reduction goals.
- Identifying these implementation challenges are necessary for energy agencies to conduct their own processes to develop resource commitments that will be needed to achieve California's goals.
