On April 2, 2025, the California Energy Commission (CEC) hosted a remote-access workshop to present and gather feedback on the Draft Consultant Report on Sea Space Analysis for Wave and Tidal Energy for Senate Bill (SB) 605 (Padilla, Chapter 405, Statutes of 2023).
