The California Energy Commission (CEC) will host a remote workshop to discuss and invite feedback on proposed regulatory language changes for the Building Energy Use Disclosure and Public Benchmarking Program. The workshop was originally scheduled for October 2, 2025, but has been rescheduled for October 13, 2025, at 10 a.m.

Interested parties may participate in the workshop consistent with the attendance instructions below. The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted, and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The workshop may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

Agenda

CEC staff will present an introduction to the Building Energy Use Disclosure and Public Benchmarking Program (Benchmarking Program) and share the proposed regulatory language changes for the program. Following the presentation, staff will transition to oral public comments. Each speaker may be limited to three minutes or less, with one person per organization.

Background

Pursuant to Assembly Bill (AB) 802, existing law requires the CEC to develop and implement a comprehensive program to achieve greater energy savings in existing residential and nonresidential buildings. In response to AB 802, the CEC adopted regulations requiring the submission and public disclosure of energy benchmarking data for certain buildings and established the Benchmarking Program. The CEC is now proposing amendments to address

extreme and unforeseen circumstances that may significantly damage or destroy buildings and affect their ability to meet reporting requirements under the Benchmarking Program.
