The California Energy Commission (CEC) will hold a follow-up meeting of the Independent Consumer Fuels Advisory Committee (ICFAC) to continue reviewing and discussing, and may vote to approve, the proposed comment letters on the *Draft Transportation Fuels Transition Plan* and *Draft Senate Bill 237 Assessment* presented during the June 23, 2026 meeting. This is a remote meeting consistent with Government Code section 11123.5, with public access online or by phone through Zoom.

On June 23, 2026, the ICFAC met to discuss the draft TFTP and SB 237 Assessment proposed comment letters drafted by three members who are subject matter experts on these topics. This meeting will be a continuation of that discussion. The meeting materials, including staff presentations and the meeting recording, are available on the CEC's website.

The CEC aims to begin promptly at the start time posted and the end time is an estimate based on the proposed agenda. The meeting may end sooner or later than the posted end time.

The session will focus on further review, clarification, and deliberation of the comment letters and will provide opportunity for ICFAC members and the public to engage in the ongoing discussion.

## **Background**

SB X1-2, the California Gas Price Gouging and Transparency Law, took effect June 2023 and established the ICFAC to provide expert advice and insight to the CEC and Division of Petroleum Market Oversight on petroleum fuels market instabilities in California. The CEC periodically hosts ICFAC meetings to receive advice on staff work related to transportation fuels market analysis. Through this work, the ICFAC supports the state's efforts to promote transparency, stability, and fairness in the transportation fuels market.

AB X2-1, which took effect January 2025, requires the CEC to consider the effects of refiners' inventory on the price of transportation fuels in California. The bill authorizes the CEC to develop requirements for refiners operating in the state to maintain minimum levels of inventories and to plan for resupply of lost production during planned maintenance or turnarounds. AB X2-1 builds upon SB X1-2, which aims to improve transparency into the petroleum industry and prevent consumer price spikes.

The CEC continues to engage with the members of the refining industry, labor, community advocates, environmental justice advocates and others to implement both laws. The CEC is taking a comprehensive approach to see what measures may stabilize supply and help to prevent and mitigate gas price volatility. The CEC is committed to ensuring there is a safe, reliable, affordable, and equitable supply of transportation fuels during the transition to a clean energy future.
